

Membership Fee and payment details

All choir members pay a membership fee each term. Fees allow us to provide members with music scores and learning tracks as well as pay our professional team and the school to hire the hall where we rehearse. We have three terms: spring term starts in January; summer term in April; and the autumn/winter term starts in September. The membership fee was last increased in September 2022 and is currently **£75**.

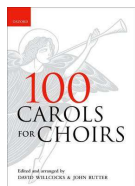
Returning choir members are asked to pay their fee during the first three weeks of term. Paying promptly eliminates unnecessary work for the volunteer treasurer. New members, who choose to join us after a free taster session, will need to pay the full term fee.
